The luxe brand has finally made its way to New York City.

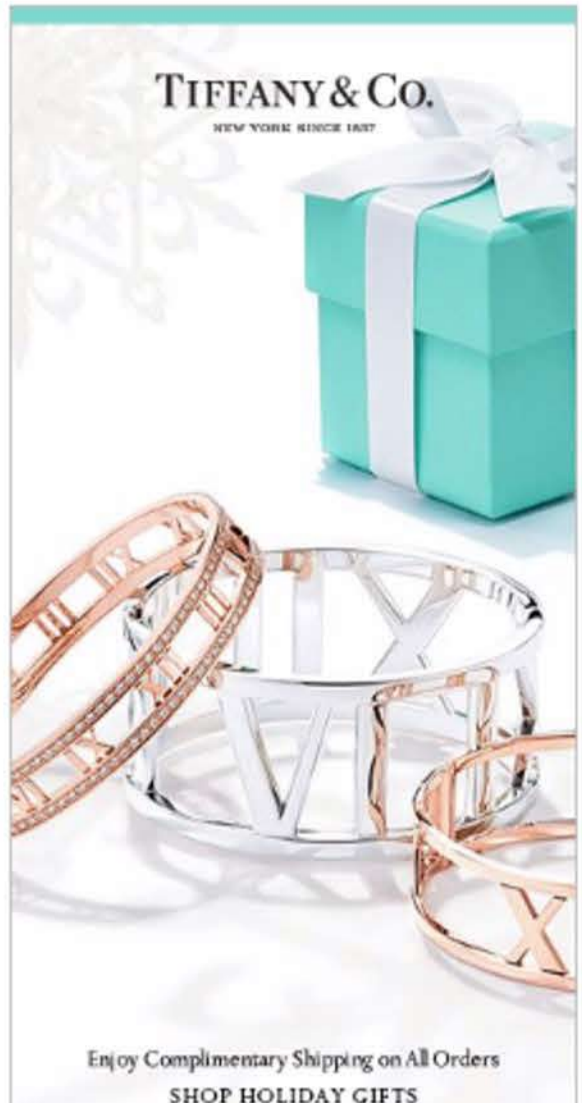


With visions of bright pink fur jackets danced in their heads.

The new shop, designed by architectural firm **Bienenstein Concepts**, is 600-square feet of innovative brilliance, featuring luxuriously embroidered carpet, creative light fixtures, and satin-brass chairs.

The brand has been a family owned and operated business since 1920 and is continuing to evolve as a modern influencer through the expansion of its namesake collection: Army, Mens, and the recently launched Children's Collection.
