

Skim the artful opus that is the **Janus et Cie** catalog, and the imprint of Janice Feldman is unmistakable. But everyone needs to collaborate now and then. So, the president and CEO shares the spotlight this

season with some kindred talents. In Fibonacci, Interior Design Hall of Fame member Michael Gabellini and partner Kimberly Sheppard capture the voluptuousness of supple materials draped over structure—in this case, handwoven JanusFiber or rattan over powder-coated galvanized steel. Seating options in the ninepiece collection include the asymmetrical Avanda recamier, its high back gradually sloping to meet the seat. The Landa lounger's bowed front points to the ground, giving rear legs a slight reveal. Ava boldly bears its legs beneath an upright seat. Conversly, circular Alba envelopes the body, balancing on tripod legs. EXTERIOR MOTIVES

THE CEO OF INNOVATIVE OUTDOOR FURNITURE COMPANY IANUS ET CIE DISCUSSES ITS LATEST INTRODUCTIONS, THE IOYS OF A FAST CAR AND THE POWER OF A PAINTBRUSH.

I'VE BEEN AN ARTIST my entire life. When I was 2, I was already painting. It's part of my DNA. I've always looked at things visually. I still paint and draw, and I always carry a sketchbook.

WHEN I WAS 20 years old, a friend of my parents gave me money to buy a container of antiques for them in Europe. I wanted to stay so I started painting portraits of tourists. During that time, I was exposed to classic architecture and early industrial design. I became completely enamored of the extruded materials and new technologies used in those products.

> AS A MARKET LEADER, it's very important to be aware of what other people in the industry are doing. But one of my great successes is that I tend to go where other people are not.

THIS YEAR, WE'RE LAUNCHING a beautiful collection called Fibonacci by Gabellini Sheppard. The pieces were inspired by the team's understanding of complex fashion and how fabric lays over structure. We're also announcing a strong association with Paola Navone.

MOVING FORWARD, I'll

continue to be very involved with product design. Last year, I designed the Arbor collection and a modular line called Boxwood, made with our JANUSfiber. This year. I created the Suki collection. Its pieces are based on antique Japanese weaving principles and were formulated to be more iconic in nature.

JANUS ET CIE is not just about furniture. We've made accessories an important part of our business and just launched an e-commerce website, shopjanusetcie.com, for them. Just like with our furnishings, we have ready-towear and couture accessories. The pieces stem from our interest in materials and converting them for other uses.

I'VE ALWAYS LOVED CARS, I like the sound of engines, industrial design, beautiful things and being able to move fast, so cars have a little piece of everything I'm interested in. I have a 1956 Talbot-Lago. It's a fantastic racecar, and I'm lucky to have it as there were so few of them made.

HIKING IN THE HIMALAYAS was a real game-changer in my life in terms of giving me the confidence to grow my business. I trekked up to 16,500 feet in Nepal, and I really had to push myself to do it. But when we push ourselves beyond what we know, that's where we find our greatness.





Rattan in the Round

Gabellini and Sheppard craft the Fibonacci Collection for JANUS et Cie



Michael Gabellini and Kimberly Sheppard, founders of New York-based Gabellini Sheppard Associates, an architecture firm known for its interiors for high-end fashion labels and museums, have designed their first furniture collection for JANUS et Cie. The Fibonacci Collection comprises a mix of natural and manmade materials and celebrates the curve.

Six seating options, made of hand-woven rattan and polished stainless steel, accommodate all forms of repose. The **Ava lounge chair** (3) and a dining version cradle the sitter in a one-piece, wafer-shaped seat. The unusual, eye-catching **Anda lounge chair** (1) features wingtips that cover the front legs and extend toward the ground. Circular in form, the **Alba lounge chair** (2) hovers atop a three-legged frame. Other lounges in the collection include the asymmetrical Avanda Recamier, which stretches 74.5 inches wide and has a sloping, high curved back, and the Vantana chaise, which

comfortably seats two, Many of the Fibonacci Collection pieces are also available for exterior use in versions made with JANUSfiber, which closely resembles the hand-woven rattan, and powder-coated galvanized steel frames.

Supplementing the collection are two tables, the Fondo and the Landa. The Fondo dining table has a circular glass top that rests on a white conical base formed from stacked bands of glass-reinforced concrete. The Fondo is also available as a side table. Providing a contrast to the curved forms, the collection's singular rectilinear offering is the Landa dining table, which features a rectangular top resting on a geometric, open base made of polished stainless steel.
